Here's a little guide to help you get the most out of the downloaded files. First of all, here's a handy character map which lets you copy and paste the charactes you need:

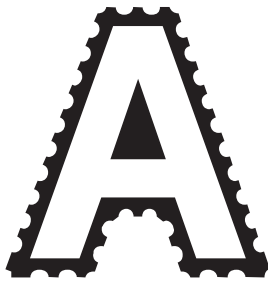

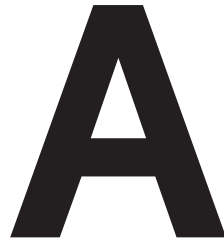

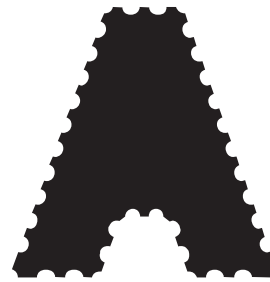
All these characters come with three variations: Regular, Filled, and Paper:

Filled

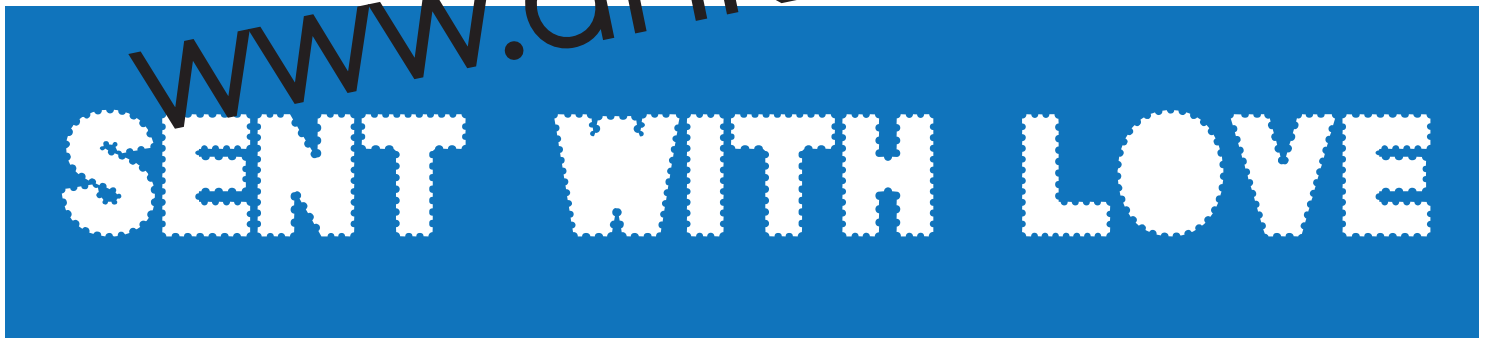

While the Regular font looks like a stamp and is readable in black and white, you can use the other layers to create realistic stamps in a graphic program (like Photoshop!).

For example, write „sent with love“ in the Paper version, white on a dark background:

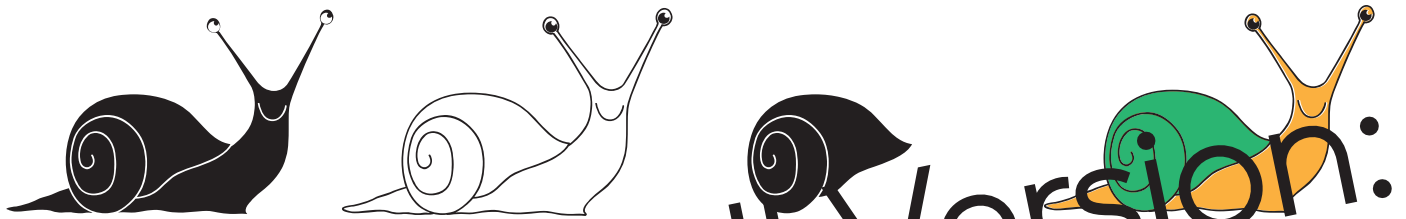


Now duplicate the white text layer, change it to the variation „Filled“ and change its color:



Get creative! You can make it as realistic as you want :)

The font even includes the snail:



use the variations „Filled“ and „Paper“ to color the „Regular“ outline.

Or create your own air mail envelope without the need for extra graphics:



It's the left parenthesis (in all three variations, colored and layered:
